Permit Conditions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Motorised aircraft are not permitted. 2. Hang gliding and paragliding operations must not be undertaken when permitted events that utilise the coastal trail are occurring. 3. Hang gliding and paragliding operations must not be undertaken during peak periods, including public holidays and public holiday weekends. 4. A person must be an official member of The Dynasoarers Hang Gliding and Paragliding Club to operate a hang glider or paraglider within the Reserve. 5. A person must hold a current certificate (HG Restricted, HG Intermediate or HG Advanced certificate) that allows for the legal operation of a hang glider or paraglider to operate a hang glider or paraglider within the Reserve. 6. A copy of this permit must be available on site when hang gliding or paragliding activities are being undertaken. 7. All hang gliding and paragliding operators must be given a copy of, and be aware of, the conditions of this Permit before operating a hang glider or paraglider within the Reserve. 8. Persons associated with hang gliding and paragliding activities must only park and set up hang gliding and paragliding equipment within the <i>Parking and Set up</i> area as shown in Appendix 1.



	<p>9. Hang gliding and paragliding operators must only launch from <i>Launch Area 1</i> or <i>Launch Area 2</i> within the Reserve as shown in Appendix 1.</p> <p>10. Hang gliding and paragliding operators must only land within the <i>Landing Area</i> or <i>Launch Area 2</i> specified in Appendix 1.</p> <p>11. Supervised Pilots (HG Restricted Certificate) must not launch a hang glider or paraglider from <i>Launch Area 1</i>.</p> <p>12. Hang gliding and paragliding operators must not launch from <i>Launch Area 1</i> on high tide (when there is no exposed rock or reef suitable for bomb-out or emergency landing).</p> <p>13. Hang gliding and paragliding operators must not launch or land within a horizontal distance of 20 metres of any Reserve user that is not associated with the hang gliding or paragliding operations.</p> <p>14. Hang gliding and paragliding operators must not fly below 100 feet (30 metres) within a horizontal distance of 20 meters of any Reserve user that is not associated with the hang gliding or paragliding operations.</p> <p>15. Hang gliding and paragliding operators must not walk across the Coastal Trail with a hang glider or paraglider if it will pose a safety risk or interfere with the activities of a trail user.</p> <p>16. Any persons associated with hang gliding and paragliding operations must ensure that only already established trails and tracks are utilised for accessing any part of the Reserve. Access to the cliff area and steep embankment adjacent <i>Launch Area 1</i> (specified in Appendix 1) is not permitted.</p>
Open fires	Open fires are not permitted.
Waste	The club must ensure that all activity related rubbish is removed from the permit site.
Sanitation	Public amenities at Steeles Rock Boat Ramp carpark are available for use.
Allocated Event Area/Public Access	<p>Please note that this Permit gives you the right to conduct your event on Bellarine Bayside managed land as indicated on the attached site plan/map.</p> <p>It does not give you exclusive use of the foreshore area outside of this allocated event area as, being Crown land, it remains public open space at all times. A clear walking path of 5 metres in width is</p>



	<p>to be maintained above the water's edge so as not to impede public access.</p> <p>Should you encounter issues with others making use of your allocated event area during your permit date and time, please contact Bellarine Bayside for assistance.</p>
